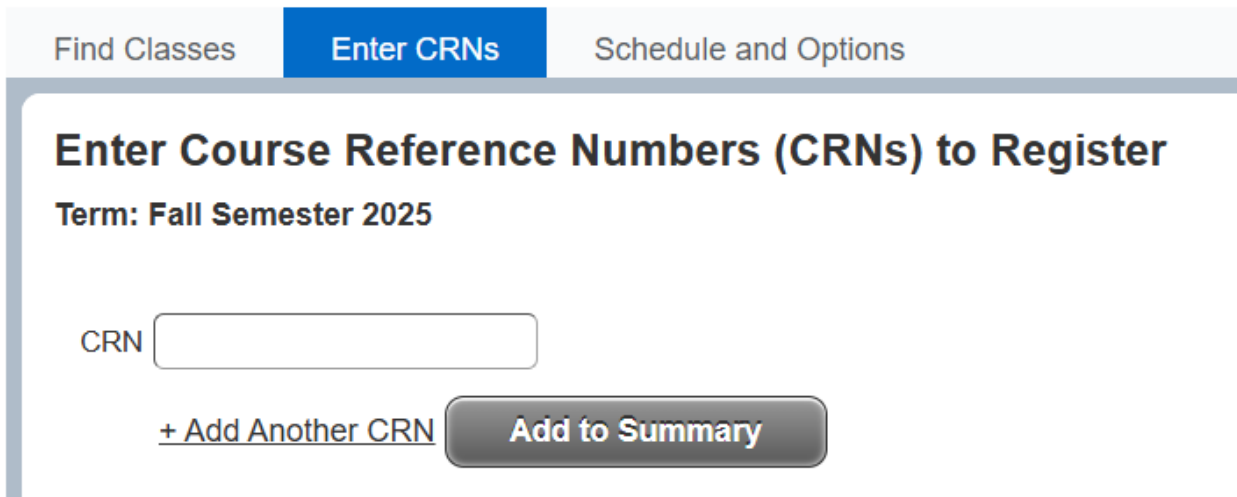


Register for Classes

Advisement days this year are April 2 and 8, and while Advisement Eve is usually a local holiday for SNC campus, it may not be so this year. Every year at this time, SNC campus is abuzz with students discussing what classes to take and with whom. RateMyProfessor usage skyrockets as students do what many consider their civic duty: evaluating classes they've taken for their fellow students. However, with uncertainty in the adjunct professors' competency, many students are unsure which classes are the best to take.

Many classes, specifically in the English and history departments, even have professors listed for classes in the fall who are retiring from or leaving SNC. Instructors for 54 classes are listed as "TBA, To Be Announced". What professor you have for a class can make or break your semester. Sometimes professors have different teaching styles than your learning styles. Classes could be the 'lecture-heavy, can't miss a day' type or 'learn on your own' by what now appears to be a flip of a coin. Or, in the worst case scenario, these classes aren't filled with new 'adjunct' hires and students are left floundering with too few credits.

Already on the first registration day, April 3, when juniors and sophomores vie for slots in classes, Knightline crashed around 8 a.m.. Delaying registration for many students and then loading slowly even later in the day after ITS confirmed the software was back to normal.

Overall, students of SNC should be proactive in preparing for registration by having selected classes in advance and already having CRNs on hand. When your time slot opens, go in right away but expect a 1-2 minute loading time on the screen. Quickly paste your CRNS and hit SUBMIT as soon as possible to be registered for your classes of choice.
