

Students Bring NFL Draft Festivities to SNC Campus

With the upcoming NFL Draft being hosted at the Green Bay Packers' very own Lambeau Field to ring in the 2025 season, 10 St. Norbert College students have jumped at the unique opportunity to get involved and earn some course credits at the same time.

This spring, students were presented with the once-in-a-lifetime chance to take a two-credit course called NFL Draft Academic Internship. This course focuses on St. Norbert College's longstanding relationship with the Green Bay Packers and discusses the potential economic impacts of such a major event. Students in the course are also collaborating on a final project of designing a tour of campus that is centered around our relationship with the Packers. The tours will be free, open to the public, and will run on April 22 and 23.

“I have always loved the Packers and been interested in learning as much [as] I can about them. I saw this course and I couldn’t pass up the opportunity to expand my knowledge on the topic,” explained one student, Faith Fehrman.

So far, students have spent the majority of their time preparing their final project: the tour. Along with traditional research methods such as combing through the St. Norbert College Archives and collections of firsthand accounts, students also got to do other things like taking a tour of Lambeau Field as a class. Not only were they able to gather more information, but they also learned more about what it takes to be an effective tour guide.

Students have certainly learned a lot already during their brief time in this course. “There are so many things I wish I could talk about in our tours that we will not be able to add because of time constraints. I think it’s going to be challenging to not go off script and add facts of my own once the tours begin,” added Fehrman.

Another student, Abigail Prudlow, also noted, “I have learned so much about the deep history that the Packers have with not only SNC but the greater Green Bay community. We truly are a one-of-a-kind team.”
