

Introduction to “Agatha All Along”

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Warning: This article contains spoilers for “WandaVision.”

“Agatha All Along” is a series about Agatha Harkness who is a rival of Wanda Maximof (a.k.a the Scarlet Witch). The series follows Agatha as she tries to regain powers lost in the final battle between her and Wanda. “At the end of “WandaVision,” Wanda cast a spell on Agatha trapping her in a delusion” (Dockterman).

With only three episodes released, there is still much to discuss; however, I will only discuss episode one so that I do not spoil future episodes. In episode one, we follow Agnes (Agatha Harkness), who is a detective, as she tries to solve a recent murder in Westview. Things take a turn when an FBI agent appears to help Agnes. That agent is Rio Vidal, the Green Witch, who leads Agnes to some very important conclusions. We are also introduced to “Teen.” His name is not known due to a spell that has been cast, which is protecting his identity. More about this spell will be revealed in episode three. At the end of episode one, Agnes realizes that she is Agatha Harkness. Tune into episode two in order to see how Agatha forms her coven to help regain her powers.

Another interesting aspect of this show is the queer representation. Not only does Teen have a boyfriend, there is a lot of tension between Agatha and the Green Witch. This is clearly portrayed near the end of episode one after the battle between Agatha and the Green Witch. Whether or not they will end up together is unclear, but for those who ship them together - there is hope after seeing their strong interaction in episode one.
